TEW MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

Requirements:

- In order to qualify for membership, the Applicant must be active within an executive, managerial, professional position, trade, government, or civic-cultural organization or is self-employed/entrepreneur.
- Applicant has successfully completed an undergraduate degree or equivalent professional certification.
- Must be a participant in community service or cultural projects or demonstrate a commitment to engaging in community service or cultural projects.
- Applicant should be sponsored by an active Member or will participate in an introductory call with a Board Member following submission of application.
- Application is reviewed and approved by the Board before membership is granted.
- At the time of approval, Applicant will pay the annual membership fee of \$150.00.
